



## AIDS 2014 DONATION PROGRAMME

The IAS is committed to reuse conference surplus by providing a donation programme at AIDS 2014 to help eliminate the waste of conference food, supplies and materials.

**This year, food donations will be made to SecondBite.**



SecondBite is a dynamic not-for-profit organisation who source fresh, nutritious food that would otherwise go to waste and redistribute it to community food programs that support people who are homeless, women and families in crisis, youth at risk, indigenous communities, asylum seekers and new arrivals.

**In addition, conference materials donations will be made to Hanover.**



Hanover is a leading Melbourne based agency which provides services to people experiencing homelessness or housing crisis. Their services include crisis, medium and long term accommodation, support and education, training and employment solutions.

Donation boxes will be available at various locations throughout the venue. Those wishing to donate items that will no longer be needed after the conference (conference bags, office supplies, exhibition material, clothes, etc.) can leave the items at any of the conference donation boxes. All materials will be redistributed by Hanover.
